

Activity: *Jao yu-sai* ? = Where are you?

- **Topic:** Positions.
- **Objective:** Students can practice saying Lao words and sentences about the positions in the conversation below.
- **Material:** A piece of cloth for covering the eyes. i.e. blindfold.
- **Vocabulary:**
 - Phuak-jao* = you
 - yu-sai* = where
 - Phuak-hao* = we
 - yu-nii* = here
- **How to play?**
 1. One student will be a blinder and stands in the middle of a circle.
 2. All the other players stand holding hands and walking around in a circle as quietly as they can.
 3. The blinder starts the conversation below.

Conversation:

(**A = Blinder** **B = All other players**)

A: *Phuak-jao yu-sai?* = Where are you?

B: *Phuak-hao yu-nii.* = We are here.

A: *Yu-sai?* = Where?

B: *Yu-nii.* = Here!

(All players sit down)

4. The blinder goes and touches a player. A player who is touched asks: "*Khoi maen phai?*" (Who am I?). The blinder answers: "*Jao maen ..(name)..*" (You are ..(name)..). If the blinder says the name of the player who he/she touches correctly then the player must become the blinder.
