1. Topic: Movement around the classroom commands

2. Learning Outcomes

- Students will be able to follow directions relating to where they should go and what they should do in and around the classroom
- Students should be able to give simple commands relating to where and what others should do in the classroom.

4. Activities (What to do)

- Introduce the vocab for sitting and standing and moving to sit on the floor and moving to sit at a desk
- Practice vocab by giving instructions and having the students follow the instructions by moving around the classroom
- Choose different student to give the commands
- Play an elimination game where the last to follow the instruction is eliminated
- Continue to use Lao commands in everyday classroom management.
- Revisit the elimination game once a week

5. Resources / Materials

- Poster of commands with pictorial representations of what the commands mean

6. Methods of Assessment of Student Achievement of Learning Outcomes

- When commands are given during the course of each day, watch to check that all students are following the instructions correctly.

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
