



**Activity: *Gem Sa-daeng-thaa-thang* = Action Game**

- **Topic:** Action Verbs
- **Objective:** Students can use simple action verbs
- **Material:** A picture card of each verb
- **Vocabulary:**
  - yeun* = to stand
  - nang* = to sit
  - nawn-yiat* = to lie down
  - nyaang* = to walk
  - dten* = to skip / jump
  - nawn* = to sleep
  - gin* = to eat
  - laen* = to run
  - lin* = to play
  - lang* = to wash
  - khian* = to write
  - aan* = to read
  - hian* = to study
  - um* = to carry/hold
  - bpin* = to climb
  - toh-la-sap* = to telephone
- **How to play:**
  1. A group of 5-6 students
  2. Students sit in a circle
  3. Put the pile of picture cards in the center with the pictures face down
  4. Each person in the circle takes a turn to pick up the card but do not let any players see the word in the card then asks the question " *khoi gam-lang het-nyang?*" (what am I

doing?) before acting out, but do not let another player see the cards. Other people in the group must guess. If one knows, he/she puts a hand up and says:

*" Jao gam-lang.....verb...."*

5. If the answer is correct the actor says: "Theuk" (correct), if not says: " Baw theuk" (incorrect).
